2. Tyre Pressure


The tyres are what connect your car to the road and provide the grip and absorb a large portion of the shock.

The air inside the tyre determines how much of each tyre comes into contact with the road/surface. So having the right amount of air would obviously be important.

Too much air would cause less of the tyre to come into contact with the road which could affect braking, cause more tyre wear in the middle portion of the tyre and adversely affect the handling.

Having too little air is also not good as more of the tyre is in contact with the road increasing friction and affecting fuel efficiency and handling.
