
6. Brake Fluid Level

We all know how important it is to have brakes that are working properly, so it seems obvious that we should be doing everything we can to make sure they do.

Checking your brake fluid levels could be a good indicator of the condition of the brakes. If the fluid is low, it could be that the brake pads are worn and need replacing.

If the brake fluid is dark, it may have become contaminated, which could affect the braking performance. And if the brakes feel spongy when pressed, it could mean that there is air in the fluid.
